

ALL ENTRIES: My entry will require (check one):

HANGING ART MUST BE FRAMED & WIRED. SEE OVER FOR INSTRUCTIONS.

Paintings and photographs must be submitted wired & framed. Make sure the center of the wire isn't any closer than 3 inches from the top frame edge.



Larger works of art should have additional hooks to keep art from "tilting" away from the wall.
